ADMISSION INTO THE 2011/2012 PART-TIME UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for admission into the 2011/2012 Part-Time Undergraduate programmes of the University of Uyo as follows:

1. FACULTY OF AGRICULTURE

- (a) B. Agric. Animal Science
- (b) B. Agric. Crop Science
- (c) B. Agric. Soil Science
- (d) B. Agric. Agricultural Economics and Extension
- (e) B. Agric. Forestry and Wildlife
- (f) B. Agric. Fisheries and Aquaculture
- (g) B. Agric. Home Economics

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

UTME: Candidates should possess at least five (5) Ordinary Level Credit passes in NECO, WASC/SSCE/GCE to include Chemistry, Biology (or Agricultural Science), Mathematics, English Language and any of Physics, Economics or Geography, at not more than two sittings.

*Credit pass in Physics is compulsory for candidates seeking admission into Home Economics or Fisheries and Aquaculture. For the other programs, at least a pass in Physics is acceptable.

*A credit pass in Health Science in place of Biology or Agricultural Science is acceptable for admission into the Fisheries and Aquaculture programme.

DIRECT ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Candidates for Direct Entry must have met the matriculation requirements as stated for those seeking admission through UTME plus any of the following:

- i. **HSC/GCE:** (Advanced Level) Atleast two HSC/GCE 'A/L' passes in Chemistry, Biology or Agricultural Science, Physics and Mathematics.
- ii. **OND/NCE:** May be admitted with at least a Lower Credit in OND/Merit in NCE into year II with adequate O/L qualifications and will run through the rest of the five-year programme.
- iii. **HND:** Candidates with HND (not less than lower credit) may be admitted into year II but would be exempted from the one-year field practical training.

2. FACULTY OF ARTS

- (a) B. A. Communication Arts
- (b) B. A. English
- (c) B. A. History and International Studies
- (d) B. A. Philosophy

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- (a) Candidates seeking admission into the Department of **Communication Arts** are expected to possess SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with 5 credit passes in the following subjects: English Language, Literature-in-English, and any other three Arts or Social Sciences subjects, in addition to a P7 in Mathematics.
- (b) Candidates seeking admission into the Department of English are expected to possess SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings, with 5 credit passes in the following subjects: English Language, Literature-in-English and any other three Arts or Social Science subjects.
- (c) Candidates seeking admission into the Department of History and International Studies are expected to possess SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with 5 credit passes in the following subjects: English Language, History/Government, and any other three Arts or Social Science subjects.
- (d) Candidates seeking admission into the Department of Philosophy are expected to possess SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with 5 credit passes including English Language and at least a pass in Mathematics or any other social science subject.

3. FACULTY OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

- (a) B. Sc. Accounting
- (b) B. Sc. Business Management
- (c) B. Sc. Banking and Finance
- (d) B. Sc. Marketing

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Candidates seeking admission into the Faculty of Business Administration are required to possess SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with 5 credit passes in the following: English Language, Mathematics, Economics and any other social science subject.

4. FACULTY OF EDUCATION

- (a) B.A. (Ed) English
- (b) B. Ed. Social Studies
- (c) B. Ed. Guidance and Counseling
- (d) B. Sc. (Ed) Political Science
- (e) B.Sc. (Ed) Health Education

- (f) B.Ed. Pre-Primary and Primary Education
- (g) Bachelor in Library and Information Science (BLIS)

- (i) Candidates seeking admission into (a) above, that is, **B.A.(Ed) English** are expected to possess SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with credit passes in five (5) subjects including English Language and Literature-in-English.
- (ii) Candidates seeking admission into **B. Ed. Guidance and Counseling** are expected to possess SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with credit passes in 5 subjects including English Language with at least a D7 in Mathematics.
- (iii) Candidates seeking admission into **B. Ed. Social Studies and B.Sc. (Ed) Political Science** are expected to possess SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with credit passes in (5) subjects including English Language, Government/History, and Economics with at least a D7 in Mathematics.
- (iv) Candidates seeking admissions into **B.Sc. (Ed.) Health Education** are expected to possess SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with five (5) credit passes including the following subjects: English Language, Mathematics and Chemistry.
- (v) For admission into **B. Ed. Pre-Primary and Primary Education** candidates are expected to possess SSCE or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with five (5) credit passes including English Language and at least a pass in mathematics.
- (i) Candidates seeking admission into **Bachelor in Library and Information Science (BLIS)** are expected to possess SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with credit passes in five (5) subjects including English Language and Mathematics.

5. FACULTY OF SOCIAL SCIENCES

- (a) B. Sc. Economics
 - (b) B. Sc. Political Science and Public Administration
 - (c) B. Sc. Sociology and Anthropology.

- (i) Candidates seeking admission into **B.Sc. Economics** are required to possess SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with credit passes in five (5) subjects including English Language, Mathematics, Economics and any other two (2) Arts or Social Science subjects.

- (ii) For **B.Sc. Political Science and Public Administration and B.Sc. Sociology and Anthropology**, candidates are expected to possess SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with credit passes in five (5) subjects including English Language, Government or History and any other three (3) subjects, with at least P7 in Mathematics.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS/INFORMATION

FIVE YEARS DEGREE PROGRAMMES

- i. Candidates should possess SSC or its equivalent with credit passes in five (5) subjects at not more than two sittings, including English Language and other Departmental and Faculty requirements.
- ii. Candidates are expected to score a minimum of 180 and above in the recent Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME).
- iii. Candidates are also expected to pass the University of Uyo Post-UTME Screening Test in Use of English Language, and three relevant subjects to qualify for admission.

DIRECT ENTRY FOR FOUR YEAR DEGREE PROGRAMMES

- i. For Direct Entry Admission, candidates are expected to possess at least Two (2) A/Level papers, NCE, Ordinary National Diploma or equivalent (at acceptable levels) in related areas plus SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings, with credit passes in 5 subjects including English Language, Mathematics, Economics and other Departmental requirements.
- ii. Candidates must attach photocopy of their UTME SLIPS.
- iii. Candidates are expected to pass University of Uyo qualifying Screening Test in the Use of English and three other relevant subjects.

DURATION

Direct Entry candidates into Part-time First Degree programmes shall spend four (4) years. UME candidates into Part-time First Degree programmes shall spend five (5) years except in all Full-Time Programmes.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Please note that all candidates with SSC examination results from 2007 downwards **must** present their certificates and not statement of result slips.
2. All completed application forms should be accompanied with the following:
 - 1 Passport size photograph
 - Photocopies of credentials
 - Photocopy of receipt of payment for the application form.

METHOD OF APPLICATION
