ADMISSION INTO THE 2011/2012 FULL-TIME CERTIFICATE AND DIPLOMA PROGRAMMES

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for admission into the 2011/2012 Certificate and Diploma programmes of the School of Continuing Education, University of Uyo, Uyo.

PROGRAMMES

1. One (1) year Full-time Certificate Programmes

(a) Faculty of Arts

(i) Certificate Course in French (CCF)

The one year Certificate Course in French is an intensive programme designed for students who may have had little or no previous knowledge of the language.

At the end of the one year certificate programme, students shall have been proficient enough in French to transact the business of their respective professions in the language. A minimum of three (3) credits are required.

(ii) Certificate in Music (CIM)

The one year Certificate course in Music is an intensive programme designed for students who may have had little or no previous knowledge of Music.

A minimum of three (3) credits including English are required for admission into the one year Certificate programme in Music.

(b.) Faculty of Environmental Studies

Certificate in Fine & Industrial Arts (CFA):

A minimum of three (3) credit passes, including English Language at the SSC or its equivalent; practical Arts experience will be an advantage.

Note: Successful completion of the Certificate programme could enable successful candidates to seek admission through Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME), into any Nigerian University, including University of Uyo, provided that they meet the University, Faculty and Departmental admission requirements.

2. **Two (2) Academic year Full-time Diploma Programmes**

a. FACULTY OF AGRICULTURE

(i) Diploma in Hotel Management and Catering Services (DHMCS)

A minimum of SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with four (4) credit passes including English Language and Chemistry and any other two from

the following subjects: Biology, Food & Nutrition, Clothing & Textile, Home Management, Agricultural Science, Health Science, Economics, French. In addition, candidates are expected to have at least a pass in Mathematics.

(ii) **Diploma in Wetlands Environmental Management and Conservation (DWEMC)**

A minimum of SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with credit passes in four (4) subjects including English Language, Chemistry and any other two from the following subjects: Agricultural Science or Biology, Mathematics or Physics, Health Science or Home Management, Economics or Geography.

(iii) **Diploma in Environmental Health Management (DEHM)**

A minimum of SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with credit passes in four (4) subjects including English Language, Chemistry and any other two from the following subjects: Agricultural Science or Biology, Health Science or Home Management, Mathematics or Physics, Economics or Geography.

b. FACULTY OF ARTS

(i) **Diploma in Theatre Arts (DTA)**

A minimum of SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with four (4) credit passes in the following subjects: English Language, Literature in English and two (2) other Arts or Social Science subjects.

A certificate in Theatre Arts from a recognized higher institution will be accepted, provided that requirement (1) above is met

(ii) **Diploma in International History and Diplomacy (DIHD)**

A minimum of SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with credit passes in four (4) subjects including English Language and History or Government.

(iii) **Diploma in Mass Communication (DMC)**

A minimum of SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with credit passes in four (4) subjects including English Language and Literature in English with at least P7 in Mathematics.

(iv) **Diploma in English (DIE)**

A minimum of SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with credit passes in four (4) subjects including English Language and Literature in English

c. FACULTY OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

Diploma in Insurance:

SSC or equivalent with credit passes in, at least four (4) subjects including Mathematics, English Language, Economics and any other Social Science subject.

d. FACULTY OF EDUCATION

Diploma in Library Science (DLS)

A minimum of Four (4) credit passes including English Language at the SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings.

e. FACULTY OF LAW

Diploma in Law (DIL)

Candidates should have SSC or its equivalent with credit passes in at least four (4) subjects including English Language and Literature-in-English at not more than two sittings.

f. FACULTY OF SOCIAL SCIENCES

- (i) Diploma in Public Administration (DPA)
- (ii) Diploma in Local Government & Rural Development (DLG)
- (iii) Diploma in Personnel Management (DPM)
- (ii) Diploma in Public Finance (DPF)
- (iii) Diploma in International Relations (DIR)
- (iv) Diploma in Social Works and Community Development (DSWD)

Candidates should have SSC or its equivalent at not more than two sittings with credit passes in four (4) subjects including the following, English Language and Government or History in addition to at least a P7 in Mathematics but for Diploma in Social Works and Community Development, a credit pass in Economics is accepted in the place of Government or History and at least P8 in Mathematics is required; for Diploma in Public Finance, credit passes in Economics and Mathematics are required in addition to credit pass in English Language.

Note: Successful completion of the Diploma programmes could enable applicants seek admission by Direct entry into the University of Uyo or any other University in Nigeria.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- (i) Please note that all candidates with SSC results from 2007 downward **must** present their certificates and not statement of result/result slips during screening.
- (ii) All completed forms should be accompanied with the following:
 - (a) 1 passport size photograph
 - (b) Photocopies of credentials

- (c) Photocopy of receipt of payment for the application form.

METHOD OF APPLICATION FOR ALL CERTIFICATE AND DIPLOMA CANDIDATES

Candidates should pay a non-refundable fee of ₦3,500.00.00 (Three Thousand, five hundred Naira) only and obtain forms at **UNIUYO MICROFINANCE BANK AT THE TOWN CAMPUS, KEY STONE BANK (FORMER BANK PHB) - UNIUYO BRANCH, UNITED BANK FOR AFRICA (UBA), AKA ROAD.** Application Forms can also be obtained from the Uniuyo Liaison Offices in Lagos (No. 2 Modupe Street, Off Kofoworola Crescent, Off Awolowo Way, Ikeja) and Abuja (No. 15B Blantyre Street, Wuse II, Abuja) with Bank Draft made payable to the School of Continuing Education, University of Uyo, Uyo; The full name and address of the candidate must be written on the reverse side of the Bank draft.
