GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

Only holders of the following qualifications are eligible to apply:

- (a) NCE with a minimum of 8 points and above in Education and the teaching subjects.
- (b) General Nursing and Midwifery/Psychiatry Nursing with at least three (3) years post qualification experience.

Candidates with (a) or (b) above must in addition, possess additional five (5) subjects at GCE (O/L), WASC/TC II, SSC including English Language at not more than 2 sittings and any other departmental requirement.

Programmes in Sciences and Vocational Education require a credit in Mathematics. Candidates intending to read Library Science should note that a credit pass in Mathematics is required.

Please note that Credit Pass in Chemistry is a requirement for candidates intending to offer Home Economics and Agricultural Education.

NOTE: Non-viable programmes that do not have up to ten (10) students admitted may not be mounted during the period and students so admitted may be required to change their programme.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

Candidates should pay a non-refundable fee of Five Thousand Naira (~~₦~~5,000.00) and obtain forms at **MAIN STREAM BANK (FORMER AFRI BANK) IKOT EKPENE ROAD, UYO**. Application forms can also be obtained with Bank Draft made payable to the School of Continuing Education, University of Uyo,

Application Forms can be obtained on presentation of genuine receipts at the School of Continuing Education, University of Uyo and from the University of Uyo Liaison Offices in Lagos (No.2 Modupe Street, off Kofoworola Crescent, off Awolowo Way, Ikeja) and Abuja (No. 15b Blantyre Street, Wuse II, Abuja).
